#### Analysis:

The annual report of Passages to Recovery, Inc. demonstrates its commitment to providing essential substance use services to a diverse clientele. With a total of 23 admissions and 21 discharges within the reported period, the program has been actively involved in catering to the substance use disorder needs of the community including mental health concerns, as 91.3% of the clientele were diagnosed with co-occurring disorders.

The average age at admission, standing at 42.73 years, indicates that Passages to Recovery, Inc. serves individuals across various age groups. The age distribution of patients further reflects this, with significant representation in the age brackets of 31-40 and 41-50, suggesting that the program's services are accessible and relevant to adults in their prime working years.

Regarding insurance coverage, Community Care Behavioral Health emerges as the primary insurer, with a significant majority of patients (22 out of 23) covered under its plans. This highlights a strong partnership between Passages to Recovery, Inc., and Community Care Behavioral Health, indicating a focus on providing accessible drug and alcohol services to a wide range of individuals.

The average length of stay, calculated at 73.35 days, suggests that patients at Passages to Recovery, Inc. receive comprehensive and sustained support during their treatment. While the highest length of stay recorded was 231 days, indicating the provision of long-term care, when necessary, the shortest length of stay was only 1 day, possibly reflecting the center's ability to provide immediate intervention and crisis management services.

In conclusion, Passages to Recovery, Inc. has demonstrated its effectiveness in addressing the substance use needs of its community, providing inclusive and comprehensive services to individuals across different age groups and insurance coverage. The program's commitment to delivering quality care is evident in its diverse patient demographics and notable events throughout the reporting period.
